<p>Who can make a nomination?</p>	<p>CIPD Chartered Members, Chartered Fellows, Chartered Companions, Academic Members and Academic Fellows can make nominations. The nominee must hold Chartered Fellow or Academic Fellow membership and have made an outstanding contribution to the people profession. You can't nominate yourself.</p>
<p>How to make a nomination</p>	<p>Please complete this nomination form and email it to our Membership Development team at companion.nomination@cipd.co.uk</p> <p>We are accepting nominations from members on an ongoing basis. Nominations will initially be reviewed by members of our Senior Leadership Team. Those considered to be exceptional will be presented to the Board for final approval. This process can take up to several months. We will inform nominators of the outcome of the process as soon as possible. A nomination will not automatically result in the award of Chartered Companion membership.</p>
<p>Unsuccessful nominations and re-nominations</p>	<p>If your nominee hasn't been successful you may re-nominate them, but a different outcome is unlikely unless you strengthen your nomination. We're unable to provide feedback on unsuccessful nominations.</p>
<p>Confidentiality</p>	<p>We treat all nominations in the strictest confidence. If a nominee is successful, we'll tell them who nominated them as long as you've consented below. We may use successful nominations for promotional purposes. We'll contact successful nominees for consent.</p>
<p>Acknowledgement and progress of nominations</p>	<p>We'll acknowledge receipt of your nomination but we can't enter into correspondence on the merits of a particular nomination. We'll contact you and the nominee if successful.</p>
<p>Changes to information submitted</p>	<p>You can't change nominations once submitted.</p>
